



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Singercraft—The

You can make silky or woolly fur grow on Scotty dogs and kittens, or muffs and scarfs, or deep pile appear on rugs so fast that you are almost ready to believe that you are a magician. You simply wind the Singercraft guide with rug wool, angora yarn, sweater wool, skein silk, cotton or rayon yarn, or rag strips—depending upon what you are making—and stitch down the slot of the guide to a backing. Then, when your design is filled in, you cut the loops and shear them to get a smooth pile effect.

Scatter rugs are effective in Singercraft, and they closely resemble hand-hooked rugs. Almost any rug design may be followed.

For beginners square rather than rounded designs are better, as the bathroom set, McCall design No. 41. This set is as practical as it is attractive made in cotton yarn in two shades of any color with black or white. The mat, made in wool, would be nice for a guest room.


